

16-19 Study Programme Requirements

Here at Grace Academy, it is our goal that all students who enter Post 16, do so from an informed viewpoint. Through a careful selection process involving preliminary interviews, independent careers advisor 1 to 1 interviews, the open evening, and a more detailed one-to-one interview schedule after written application, students have a study programme shaped around their progress and attainment to date (based on projected grades initially, but refined in light of achieved grades before taking the Post 16 place on offer), education and career goals. In 2017/18

Study programmes include academic qualifications in the form of A-levels and applied and vocational qualifications. More recently provision for 2018/19 study programmes consist of 3 Extended Diplomas (3 A level equivalents) in Computing, Health and Social Care and Sport. All students gain entry to Post 16 with a level 4 GCSE in English and maths.

We work closely with local providers and also with more national providers, to offer students work experience and a comprehensive view on apprenticeships. University visits, outreach visits and careers fair visits complete our programme of information on the next steps.
