These have been unprecedented times of challenge for us all and I would like to thank you for your support and understanding during this first term back. This support and understanding has allowed us to deliver a full curriculum to the high standards you would expect. I have been amazed by the resilience and flexibility of staff and students to adapt to a different way of working.

Many of the lessons I see on a daily basis are outstanding, with students engaged and clear learning and progress being made.
