Dear Parent/Carer,

The take up of 'on-line' provision has been outstanding with recent year groups having 98% take up. I would like to thank the parents and carers for supporting the academy in making this work. The hardest decision a head teacher can take is to send a student home, we know the best place for them to learn is in front of outstanding professional teachers. Even in these odd times the students have yet again shown their dexterity in continuing to do amazing things. In particular this term we have seen students show remarkable respect for the Remembrance Day commemoration. At this event our new head boy and head girl, Caesar and Notoya, led a memorial service in the academy grounds on behalf of all students. Pupils have been involved in collecting and distributing over 5000 items of food for Helping Hands and Birmingham City Mission Foodbank. Covid has also impacted on our annual community Christmas meal, which is something staff, students and the community have looked forward to for a number of years now. ## Advising the school of Covid related issues from the 19th December

Should your child receive confirmation of a positive test within the first 48hrs of school closure or a positive test with Covid symptoms (high temperature, loss of taste or smell or a new, continuous cough) emerging within 48 hours of pupils being in school, parents should email the academy at:

Should your child receive a positive test with symptoms emerging from Monday 21st December onwards then there is no need to contact the school, please follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace.
