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Dear Parent/Carer

Thank you for your continued support with engaging your child in remote learning, which has been greatly successful. We are currently seeing on average 96% of students accessing the remote learning platform and a high number of students completing progress checks and receiving weekly feedback from subject experts. We would appreciate your continued assistance with this as we approach half term.

In addition to the wide range of well-being specific student support available from the academy, both in person and online, we are introducing a **live Google Meet tutor session**. These sessions will last for 10 minutes, will be led by a member of staff from the ethos team, and will give students the chance to ask any questions about that week's assembly topic, which are focused around supporting your child during lock down. This will also be a chance for your child to speak to a member of staff directly and allow students to interact and engage with their Tutor group peers.

These sessions will form part of their normal timetabled day and students will also be able to see and be seen by the teacher, as well as by the rest of their class. This will continue to help them to feel connected with the academy and their peers.

As always, we expect the highest standards of behaviour during these sessions and therefore have outlined what we expect from students below, and how you can support them with this:

## As a Pupil you should:

- Behave and show respect for others as you would during assemblies or lessons in school.
- Always conduct a meeting in an open space and with a blank wall behind you.
- Only communicate through the live Google Meet chat function or the school email.
- Follow the teacher's instructions at all times.
- Not discuss personal matters in the live sessions.
- Wear appropriate clothing as you are not expected to wear school uniform. Acceptable clothing includes a full length top and leggings/tracksuit bottoms/jeans.
- Make sure you mute yourself if you don't need to speak and use the 'raise hand' option if you want to ask a question or speak.
- Enjoy the session and ensure you make the effort to engage with your camera turned on we know this is daunting but is proven to have positive benefits and will only be for a short time, while a register is taken.
