A Level Results Day – Tuesday August 10th

As we have communicated previously in line with government guidance, grades for this academic year were determined by teachers based upon a range of evidence that students provided. Details on this process including how students were assessed, the evidence used, how to request special consideration and guidance on the appeals process can be found in previous communications on the “Awarding Grades 2021” page under the parent section of our website. Following a rigorous in school quality assurance process, student grades submitted by teachers will be reviewed by the exam boards before they award the final grades.

These final grades will be released to students on results days this year, which for year 13 students will take place on Tuesday 10th August. Under government guidance we are not allowed to release information regarding these grades before this date and we must also confirm that judgements have not been influenced by pressure from students or parents/carers.

This will be a fantastic opportunity for you to discuss your results with post 16 staff and for us to help any student who may want to go through clearing or make adjustments to their UCAS application.
