Admissions

We are an inclusive, all ability community school that has committed to follow the Local Authority Co-ordinated Admission Arrangements. Information on Grace Academy can be obtained from this prospectus, the Local Authority Admission Arrangements for Secondary Schools Booklet, our website and parents' evenings which will take place in the autumn term, prior to the submission of application forms.

Applications will then be considered by the Local Authority, in consultation with Grace Academy and offers will be distributed to and confirmed by parents during the Spring Term.

Grace Academy is an independent state school but does not charge any fees.

The admission criteria are as follows:

Priority 1

- A. Looked after children and previously looked after children who are now adopted or subject to a residence order or special guardianship order
- B. Children whose exceptional circumstances for social or medical reasons can only be met at this school

Priority 2 Children who normally live in the school's catchment area

Priority 3 Children who have an older brother or sister at the school at the same time

Priority 4 Children living closest to the school, measured in a straight line from the child's home

Timetable and admission limits are defined in the Local Authority Co-ordinated Admission Arrangement Booklet.
