Free School Meals (FSM)

You may be eligible for Free School Meals if you receive a qualifying benefit.

This could be:

- Universal Credit your household earned annual income must be less than £7,400 after tax and not including any benefits
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Once the roll out of Universal Credit is completed in March 2023 anyone who no longer meets the the eligibility criteria, either because their earnings are above the limit or if they no longer receive Universal Credit, will continue to receive Free School Meals until the end of their current phase of education (i.e. primary or secondary).

The Universal Credit rollout is currently expected to complete in March 2023.




