The majority of students attending the ARC will have SEMH or behavioural needs. The work within the ARC is all of a restorative nature to educate and develop students' coping mechanisms and behavioural attitudes alongside supporting their academic needs

- Support students placed in the ARC and bring about sustained change to disadvantaged students who need help overcoming barriers to learning, where behaviour and attendance issues are a cause for concern
- Promote the achievement of high standards through effective mentoring and behaviour management
