

Accessing Labour Market Information on Unifrog

Follow these steps for different job searches:

1. On the home page scroll down until you see 'Explore Pathways' and select the 'Careers Library'.

2. You will then have the option to either search for a keyword or by subjects. You can type in one of the options or both. Once complete select 'Go'.
