BTEC Performance assessment

Comprised of 4 units

3 units are mandatory and the final 1 unit is chosen based on the strengths within the group (360 guided learning hours)

Unit 1: Mandatory - Investigating practitioners work - external assessment.

Unit 2: Mandatory – developing skills and techniques for performance assessed internally.

Unit 3: Mandatory- Group performance workshop (120 GLH) externally assessed.

Option units: (1 unit)

Screen Acting/Interpreting Classical Text for Performance/Acting styles/
Developing the Voice for Performance/Improvisation/Movement in Performance/Musical theatre techniques and variety performance.

Practical course

The Performing Arts BTEC qualification suite offers a combination of mandatory and optional units.

It will also help you take increased responsibility for your own development. The demands within industry mean you need to be able to manage deadlines and communicate your ideas in different ways.
