Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: KS3 Parent Review Day for years 7-9 on 12.03.26

We believe that an effective partnership between a school and home is essential in supporting students in making good progress during their time with us here at Grace Academy Solihull. This partnership is built on good communication about your child's progress, therefore we will be running a Parent Review Day on **Thursday 12 March** to enable you to speak directly to your child's teachers regarding their progress in each subject. These meetings will take place **between 13:15 and 19:00**. The hope is that this flexible extended day will give you a better opportunity to book meetings and discuss your child's progress with their subject teachers, identifying future steps to success.

How do these meetings allow you to support your child?

- An opportunity to discuss your child's progress with subject experts
- Allow a discussion about how we can work together to support your child's progress
- An opportunity for us to signpost useful resources
- A space to highlight any barriers and focus on solutions for your child
- A chance to reflect on your child's most recent academic report

To facilitate these, **students in all years will be finishing school at 12:30** on Thursday 12 March.

These parent-teacher meetings will be conducted in person at the academy. We believe it is very important for **students to attend with their parents/carers** as your presence will act as a support and motivation for your child - students will **not need to wear their school uniform for this**.

You will have already received your child's latest assessment report which outlines their current and expected progress in all subjects, as well as their attitude to learning. This should support you in ensuring that you can speak to the subject areas in which your child needs most support.

In order to ensure that you have an opportunity to discuss each subject with your child's teachers, it is essential for your child to make appointments with each teacher beforehand and that these timings are met. All students will be given an appointment slip on **Friday 27 February** which they will be required to fill in. Please note there will be **no appointments between 15.00 and 15.40**.
