RE: Year 6 Transition Day

As mentioned previously, your child has been invited to our **Year 6 Transition Day on Thursday 2 July**. The aim of this day is for students to experience the academy on a normal day, helping them to feel more confident moving around the building, as well as giving them the opportunity to meet some of our teachers and their peers, prior to starting in September.

On the day please ensure that your child arrives at the academy for a 9.30 am start, dressed in their junior school uniform. Lunch and a break time snack will be supplied, but students are also welcome to bring a packed lunch if they prefer. Students are allowed to drink water during lessons, therefore they can also bring a bottle of water with them. Please note that fizzy or energy drinks are not allowed at the academy, however a drink of juice or squash for lunch time is acceptable and water will also be available at break and lunch as well. The day will end at 2.15 pm at which time the students will be dismissed from the academy and are either able to be picked up or, with your permission (see below), can make their own way home.

The day will include a reminder of our Academy expectations, as well as to our successful Restorative Justice system. Students will also have taster lessons in a number of subject areas, therefore allowing them to meet some of our teachers. Students will participate in these sessions and will move between them and around the academy in their tutor groups.
